The Personal Project occupies a central position in the MYP framework

The aims of the MYP Personal Projects

- ► To research relevant topics within a Global Context
- ► To demonstrate the skills, attitudes and knowledge needed to complete a project over an extended period of time
- To develop deeper understandings through in-depth investigation
- ► To reflect on learning and knowledge
- ▶ To communicate effectively in a variety of situations
- ► To appreciate the process of learning and develop confidence as a lifelong learner
- To engage in principled action

Throughout the project, students focus on the completion of 3 essential components

- 1. the Process Journal
- 2. the Product/Outcome
- 3. the Report

Stages

- Investigating
- ▶ Planning
- ► Taking Action
- ► Reflecting
- Writing the Report
- Demonstrating

Documentation

Through keeping an individual process journal on Google Classroom

In this process journal, students should:

- document all rough ideas, rough drawings, etc.
- record progress in the journal, using notes/drawings to reflect on ideas, achievements, obstacles, etc.
- Reflect on growth and improvement in terms of knowledge and skills

Investigating

Here, students will:

- Brainstorm to identify a suitable topic that THEY are interested in
- Identify relevant prior learning and subject knowledge
- Identify ONE Global Context and exploration
- Formulate a challenging, realistic goal that THEY can accomplish

The goal should be starting with:

- To offer a solution
- To inform
- To direct
- To compose
- To explore
- To write and publish
- Determine a product / outcome (an app, a play, a book, a documentary, a service, and event)
- Find reliable, relevant sources to conduct your research

Planning

- Continue research
- ► Create success criteria to evaluate product / outcome

 Which they will use to evaluate the success of their project?
- Develop an action plan to create product / outcome
 Here they create short and long term plans
- Record all process in the Process Journal

Taking Action

That's when they use the research and planning to create the outcome/product. Here they:

- ► Analyse and evaluate information -Why does this information matter? How is it relevant to my goal?
- ► Transfer and apply research to your goal by: making decisions, creating solutions, developing understanding
- Create the product / outcome defined by your goal

Reflecting

Now it's time to measure the impact/success

- Evaluate the product / outcome using success criteria
- Explain how the project extends knowledge/understanding of the topic and global context
- Explain how completing the project made him/her grow as a learner
- Explain how what was learned has impacted his/her attitudes and behaviour

Writing the Report

- Use their Process Journal to write the report
- Must follow the required format
- Will learn how to write clearly and concisely
- ► Will choose a number of PJ extracts in the Appendix one of which includes photo of project

Assessment
