# Students study concurrently:

- three subjects at higher level (240 hours each).
- three subjects at standard level (150 hours each).
- all three parts of the core.

#### Where should students be at NOW:

- Decided on subject area
- Explored **subject specific areas** for study: e.g., topic, concepts, theories, issue, framework
- Identified specifics: e.g.,
- a business + specific theory or principle
- literature text + theory or aspect,
- a phenomenon of language;
- historical event, person, concept;
- application of DT concept;
- comparison of aspect of two artists' work
- psychological issue evaluation of research;
- scientific method to solve a science issue;
- CS problem or CS solution to a real-life problem;
- application of economic theory to real life issue;
- contemporary global political issue

# **Contents:** What does the Diploma Programme curriculum contain?

There are three core requirements:

# Creativity, activity and service (CAS):

- Part of the DP Core and an IAA requirement
- Encourages students to be involved in artistic pursuits, sports and community service
- Education outside the classroom
- Provides stress relief and balance
- Resourceful for University applications and CVs
- Progress recorded on ManageBac



### **CAS Examples of Experiences and Projects**

- Cooking courses (creativity and service)
- Group and team sports i.e. football, basketball, swimming (activity)
- Tutoring for younger students and/or teachers (service)
- Helping elders with groceries and donations to old age homes (service)
- Learn a new skill and take an online class through <u>Coursera</u>, <u>Udemy</u>, <u>Khan</u>
   <u>Academy</u> or many of the other online learning platforms (<u>creativity</u>, maybe activity if it's a sports class)
- Do sports challenges with friends and neighbors i.e. who can hold a plank the longest? Football tournaments etc. (activity)
- Host a session with your friends for some mindful yoga or Pilates. Maybe even open up the class to their family and other friends (activity)
- Start taking care of your diet analyse your diet and create an informed nutritional plan with recipe ideas and juice recipes. You could use the website <a href="HappyForks">HappyForks</a> or the <a href="myfood24">myfood24</a> app (creativity, activity)
- Get involved with school activities i.e. fashion show, IMUN etc. (creativity)
- Support communities in and around Amman with clothes drives, animal welfare and food packages through local charities and institutions (service)

#### IB Diploma vs. IB Certificate

What is the difference between an IB Diploma and an IB certificate when it comes to university applications?

UK	IB certificate students are typically required to apply for a foundation year. Some universities however will accept first-year students if they are taking three HL subjects.
USA	Pursuing an IB certificate has no impact on applications.
EUROPE	Most universities do not accept IB certificates.
CANADA	Most universities do not accept IB certificates. There may be a few universities that do, but they aren't usually highly ranked.
JORDAN	Pursuing an IB certificate has no impact on applications.
